SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS FOR PLAY DAYS



1. Only one player on the tee box at a time and be sure to never get ahead of another player who is hitting.
2. Be ready when it's your turn to hit. **Play Ready Golf. Move quickly between shots.** Watch each other's ball.
3. Only one practice swing.
4. Put bags down off the green on the way to the next tee. Also, not on the tee boxes.
5. Put the flagstick down gently on the green, away from the hole and out of other player's way in case they over-shoot the hole.
6. Continuous putting rule will be in effect for pace of play purposes. The player furthest from the hole will continue to putt until the ball is holed out. Walk gently on the greens—make sure to pick up your feet!
7. Count all your strokes, including Whiffs! **Max 10 strokes per hole!**
8. Be considerate of other players: don't talk while they are hitting, yell "FORE" if needed, rake bunkers, play according to the rules and have fun! Replace Divots and Repair Ball marks on the green!
9. The following unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated in the Crystal Lake Junior Program:
 - Throwing Clubs or Slamming them into the ground
 - Swearing
 - Damaging Greens or any area of the golf course.
 - Failure to Replace Divots and/or Repair Ball Marks.
 - Littering
10. Be sure to sign your scorecard and turn it in at the end of your round.



Leave the golf course immediately if you hear thunder or see lightning!
